





For accounting professionals interested in advancing their communication, interpersonal, technological, and applied research expertise, the UAB **Master of Accounting** online program prepares graduates to sit for the Certified Public Accountant (CPA) exam and bolster their existing abilities and opportunities.

Bridge Program

The Bridge Program is for those individuals interested in the online M.Ac. program who **DO NOT** hold an undergraduate degree in accounting from an AACSB-accredited institution, or who have earned their undergraduate accounting degree more than 5 years ago. The Bridge Program courses are indicated in the far right column. M.Ac. applicants with undergraduate accounting degrees that are more than 5 years old will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis to determine if any of their undergraduate accounting courses are eligible for transfer.
